






We welcome you to check in your birds for supervised public shopping.

> Location: Show Hall Sale Room Rules

• Members of the National Bird Show may sell birds through the sales room.

• Each bird must be registered. Forms are available at the registration table or at the Sale Room. Fee is \$2.00 per bird with a maximum of \$50 per member.

- The sale room operators will receive 10% of each sale.
- Sellers must place the birds in clean, appropriately sized cages with food and water.
- Do not overcrowd the birds.
- NATIONAL Bird Sales · Sellers should identify the birds and Room indicate whether they are pets or breeders, type of food they are accustomed to and ny special requirements or conditions the buyer should know
- Only healthy stock may be sold.
- The sales staff may refuse any cage they deem to be inappropriate.
- Owners may assist sales room staff with selling of their own birds but not with the financial transaction.
- Sales room cashiers will handle ALL financial transactions in the bird sale room.
- Only birds for sale may be brought into the bird sales room.
- The sellers will be paid at closing on Saturday.
- The sales room operators will be the final arbiter of these procedures and reserves the right to amend or revise them as deemed necessary.
- All purchases must be paid in cash. All sales are final and there will be no refunds.

She is a prominent authority on Gloster canaries and has had best Gloster at many shows including NBS. She has judged both the Gloster and Fife divisions at the National. Regina is known as the Gloster lady, mini drinker lady and more recently the bird band lady. NBS is proud to recognize her service to the National.
- 2023 Sally Huntington has been a long time member and supporter of the National. She has supported all forms of aviculture as a judge of finches and softballs, author, editor and exhibitor. She has both won a Higgins and judged the Finch Division at National. NCBS is proud to recognize her service to aviculture and especially to NCBS.

This award was established in 1981 to acknowledge those who have given notable support to the NBS.

Wendy Edwards attended her first National in 2001. She has been a successful exhibitor winning multiple Love Bird Division Higgins Awards. She is also certified Love Bird judge and has judged the Peachfaced and Rare & Eyerings Lovebird Divisions at the National on three occasions and is the only female "Love Bird" Judge in the world. Wendy has traveled to Europe to visit the the major Love Bird shows and meet the breeders, exhibitors and judges in Europe.

Wendy's services to NCBS has included: show catalog editor and advertising solicitor, judge's coordinator and hospitality chairman, and since 2017. The National Bird Show is happy to recognize the service of Wendy Edwards.

SHOW RULES

- 1. Only National Bird Show members may enter birds.
- Advance entry fee shall be \$5.00 per cage with a maximum of \$150/member.
 Onsite entry fee shall be \$6.00 per cage with no maximum.
 Entry fee for sale birds shall be \$2.00 per bird with a maximum of \$50/member.
- Separate entry forms are required for each Division.
 Exhibitor assumes responsibility for legality of his entry.
 Entry forms and cage tags will be available starting 10am THURSDAY.
- 4. Entry forms must be completely filled out and used as follows: White: to Show Secretary table by 7pm Thursday. Yellow: Exhibitor copy for checkout on SATURDAY. All white copies must be to Show Secretary table by 7pm Thursday. No forms or tags will be sold Friday, sale birds excepted.

Birds will be received in the show hall 2pm to 7pm THURSDAY. Entered birds may be brought to the show hall between 6 and 7am Friday, however, these must be in the secretary books Thursday. All birds will be on the benches by 7am Friday, judging starts at 8:15am. American Singers require all entries be made prior to 9pm Thursday.

- 5. All entries must be bona fide property of exhibitor at least one year (365 days) prior to the show. To compete for the Higgins Trophy all birds must be bred and banded by the exhibitor except for Finch and Parrot divisions. These need not be banded. Higgins winners and band numbers may be published in the NBS newsletter. Band numbers will be verified with the division secretary and Scannell coordinator before leaving the show bench.
- 6. To compete in unflighted (young) classes all entries must be bred and banded with a recognized, current year, traceable and closed band.
- 7. All birds that are flighted, or with open bands or unbanded, or with unrecognized or non-readily traceable bands, must compete in the old (open) classes.
- 8. Any bird purchased within one year from a judge cannot be shown at NBS when that judge is officiating in that division at the show. No judge/exhibitor nor his partners or family members can win any award he has participation on the decision of the winner.

SHOW RULES (CONTINUED)

- 9. Higgins winners from all song canary divisions will compete for the Best Song Canary in Show award. All other Higgins winners compete for the Scannell Trophy. Higgins winners in Finch, Parrot, Peachfaced Lovebirds, Rare Lovebirds and Cockatiels will compete for the Charlie Anchor Award for Best Foreign Bird.
- 10. Only one bird in a cage may be shown except in Finch Pairs section.
- 11. Every possible attention will be given to the care of the birds, but the National Bird Show, Inc. and sponsoring clubs will not be held responsible for any accident, mistake, loss, theft or damage that may occur to any exhibit.
- 12. All birds must be checked on entering and leaving the show room. After birds are entered and checked-in they are under the care of the show management. They are not to be handled except by direct permission of the show manager. If drinkers or feeders are removed for judging by the stewards they should be replaced by the stewards. If this has not been done the exhibitor should notify the show management and have it done by those responsible for handling the exhibit.
- 13. No birds, drinkers or feeders shall be removed from their individual cages, except by the Chief Steward. While entered in the show entries are under the control of NBS.
- 14. Show management has the right to add, combine or withdraw classes as the number of entries dictates.
- 15. No identification, signs or display advertising will be allowed on or about any cage until judging has concluded.
- 16. Special awards given for club bands or membership will not be awarded unless exhibitor's eligibility is indicated on the entry form. All special awards will be judged and/or presented after division judging has been completed.
- 17. Judging by daylight or Vitalite or equivalent as the situation dictates.
- 18. Colorbred canaries will be judged by the point system.
- 19. Cage bottoms should be covered with a regular seed mixture relative to the particular species. Song birds use white paper. Feed and water must be available in all cages.

SHOW RULES (CONTINUED)

- 20. No steward is authorized to reclassify an entry. Only a judge has the authority to reclassify an entered bird.
- 21. The judge has the right to withhold awards if the judge feels the bird does not warrant the award. The Scannell Coordinator is to check bands after judging for bred and banded by the exhibitor. During judging, judges are not to use cell phones. English language is to be used to communicate with stewards, secretaries, award helpers and gallery, either by the judge or through an interpreter. Apprentice judging is not permitted at the NBS.
- 22. Decisions of the judge are final.
- 23. Cut-off time for judging is 5pm Friday. If the Division is not finished the judging will resume Saturday morning at 7am.
- 24. Entries shall be checked out at the time posted on the itinerary.
- 25. The NBS Board of Directors reserves the right to interpret all rules and regulations and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions and differences in regard thereto. It also reserves the right to amend and add to these rules. All complaints must be written and submitted with a \$100.00 fee to the Board prior to the NBS general meeting.
- 26. Youth Division entries are governed by all rules listed above and Youth Division rules which are listed in Division 19 Youth.

The American Singers Club, Inc. (ASC) was founded in 1934 in Milton, MA by a group of 8 enthusiastic breeders. The first show was held in Boston that same year! The name 'American Singers' was adopted by vote of the members after the first show. This breed has been standardized and is the only American bred canary known as the 'AMERICAN SINGER'. The ASC Constitution, Bylaws and Standards were adopted in 1943, along with a 100 Point Score Sheet and instructions for Judges to use at all sanctioned AMERICAN SINGERS shows.

Our breed is a Song Type Canary bred through the blending of Roller to Border Fancy over a period of years. American Singers are bred to produce a Canary that has (1) an outstanding and free harmonious song, pleasing to the ear, neither too loud or too harsh, with plenty of Variety; and (2) a beautiful sleek shape about 5-3/4 inches long. While American Singer Canaries come in many different colors, the breed is not judged based on color and type alone – they are primarily judged on song quality. Genuine American Singers are banded with closed bands purchased from the ASC Secretary and bear the initials "ASC" along with the year the chick was hatched. If you would like to bring home an American Singer Canary, you can talk to the registered ASC members and breeders in the holding room.

Youth Show Guidelines

Youth exhibitors will be responsible for showing their own birds in the Youth Show at the National Bird Show. This includes checking in and checking out their birds during the event.

This year's Youth Show will feature a 100-point evaluation scale to determine the Best Youth Bird at the National Bird Show. The competition is open to all NBS members age 18 and under.

The scoring guide will be divided into two parts:

1. Show Standard – 50 Points

This portion will be completed by the official judge of the division in which the bird is entered.

The judge will evaluate how well the bird conforms to the established standard for its species.

• Example: A bird that is an excellent representation of its species' standard may receive

40–50 points in this category.

2. Knowledge of the Bird -50 Points

This portion will assess the exhibitor's understanding and care of their bird. The NBS Director of Youth will interview the participants. Youth participants may be asked questions such as:

- How do you care for your bird?
- What size and type of show cage is used for this bird species?
- What kind of seed or diet do you feed your bird?
- How do you prepare your bird for a show?
- How do you identify this bird species?
- What does the judging standard look like for this species?

This two-part system is designed to recognize not only the quality of the bird, but also the knowledge, effort, and dedication of the young exhibitor.

Youth ShowGuidelines

Birds exhibited by youth will be judged at the start of the show in each Division. The Youth Exhibitor needs to be present at the judging bench. After the youth birds are judged the Division Steward will move the youth bird back to the holding area and the bird will be judged again with the general entries.

The National Cage Bird Show Youth College Scholarship

The National Cage Bird Show and Exhibits, INC, has paid out nine scholarships to eight Youth Scholarship winners.

These are the regulations for claiming the National Cage Bird Show Youth Scholarship:

- 1. The Scholarship is to be used at the college of the student's choice, including community college, vocational school, technical school or any fully accredited college or university.
- 2. A maximum of four Scholarships may be won by any one student.
- 3. The student is to notify the National Cage Bird Show and Exhibits Inc. of enrollment and supply verification from the college.
- 4. The Scholarship is to be used with the Fall enrollment following high school graduation and be used in consecutive years if the student has accumulated more than one scholarship.
- 5. The Scholarship funds are to be paid directly to the school for use as tuition, fees and supplies.
- 6. If a refund becomes due, it is to be returned to NCBS.
